




Noble Laureate Dr. R. K. Pachauri addresses the gathering.

CC Lifetime Achievement Award

The 5th ICC Lifetime Achievement Award was presented to Dr R K Pachauri' Director General of The Energy And Resources Institute and Chairman of The Intergovernmental Panel On Climate Control, on February 19, 2009 for his contributions towards developing awareness about man-made climate change and laying the foundation for measures needed to counter such effects. Instituted by the ICC Calcutta Foundation, the award comes with a citation, a specially designed trophy and a token prize of Rs 2 lakhs. In the past this award has been conferred on Pt. Ravi Shankar, Prof. Amartya Sen, Prof. Jagdish Bhagwati and Ms. Kiran Mazumdar Shaw.

Dr. Pachauri was awarded the Second Highest Civilian Award in India, The Padma Vibhushan as well as The Padma Bhushan before it for services to the environment from The Government of France, he received 'The Officier De La Legion D' Honneur' in 2006. Dr Pachauri shared the podium with Al Gore to receive the 2007 Nobel Prize Peace Prize on behalf of the IPCC.

Mr. Buddhadeb Bhattacharjee, Chief Minister of West Bengal, presented the trophy while Mrs. Rakhi Sarkar, Trustee and Hon. General Secretary of the ICC Calcutta Foundation read out the citation. Welcoming the guests, Mr. Raghu Mody, Chairman, The Rasoi Group and Trustee, ICC Calcutta Foundation spoke about Dr Pachauri's important role as a leading global thinker and leader of research and as an international statesman promoting climate change awareness.


The programme was attended by a large gathering of business leaders, environmentalists, academicians, distinguished citizens and members of the media.





Joke #2




World Kidney Day was observed by National Kidney Federation India on 12th March 2009 in Mumbai.
